


Needlestick Prevention



It's a fact: used needles and other sharp objects are not always disposed of properly. Hospital laundry workers and uniform rental workers are at high risk and the medical, counseling, and lost time expenses resulting from a needle stick can cost an organization up to \$2,100. If the employee is infected, those costs may rise to more than \$30,000 in annual medical costs alone. Indemnity costs are not even included. These employees must be protected!

25 Gauge Needlestick Tests



Made with SuperFabric brand material by HDM, Inc., the PointGuard™ VII and the HiDex™ NSR gloves provide unmatched cut and puncture resistance. The average needle resistance of the Level 6 gloves for a 25 gauge needle is 2.27 lbsF, 78% more than Turtleskin and 530% more than Gimbel. The cut resistance provided in these gloves is 5000 grams (based

on standard tests). This is equivalent to almost 4 times the cut resistance provided by Dupont's Kevlar®. 100% washable and resusable, these gloves can be worn in conjunction with the necessary blood borne pathogen barriers (latex gloves, vinyl gloves).
